nicht zu bremsen ist der Baum.

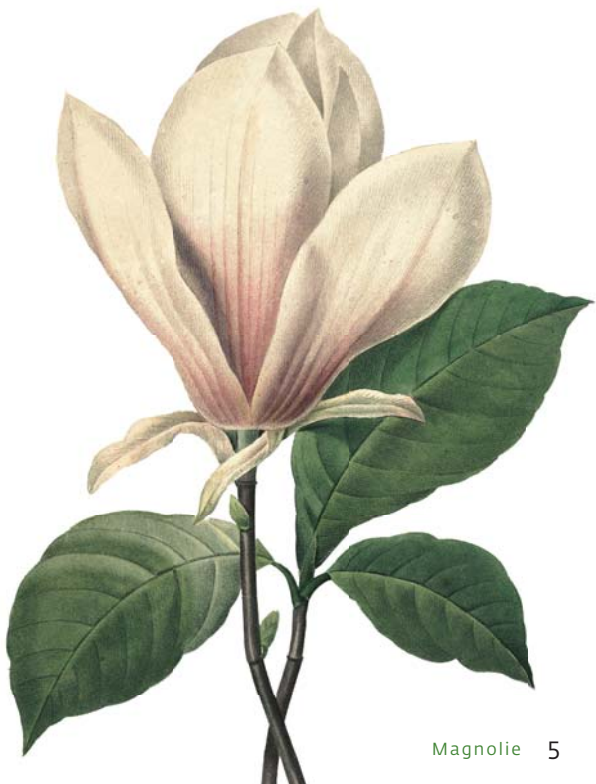
Es war wohl ein Sonnenstrahl,
